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## Gardasil HPV Immunization

### Patient Information

1. Gardasil is a vaccine to protect against diseases caused by HPV.
  - a. Cervical cancer.
  - b. Abnormal and precancerous cervical lesions, vaginal lesions, vulvar lesions and genital warts.
2. Gardasil is given to girls and women ages 9 through 26 years old.
3. Gardasil is given in 3 dose injections.
  - a. First dose: At any visit
  - b. Second dose: 2 months after first dose.
  - c. Third dose: 6 months after first dose.
4. These appointments are scheduled as lab appointments at check out.
5. Ingredients are purified inactive proteins that come from HPV. It also contains amorphous aluminum hydroxyphosphate, sulfate, sodium chloride, L-histidine, polysorbate 80, sodium borate and water. Contraindicated if allergic to any ingredients.
6. Not all insurances cover this immunization. Please contact your insurance company for coverage. You may provide them with diagnosis and CPT codes.

  - c. CPT 90471 Injection
